# Saariselka

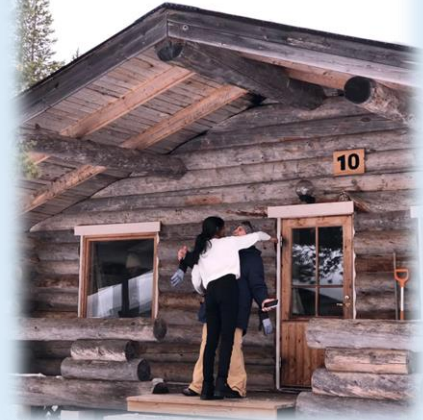
*We were lucky enough to witness the aurora borealis after the long road trip without even hunting straight from our cabins right on the first night in the Lapland!!!*

*It was so magical to lay down in the snow & see the lights dancing above and gaze the infinite amounts of stars*



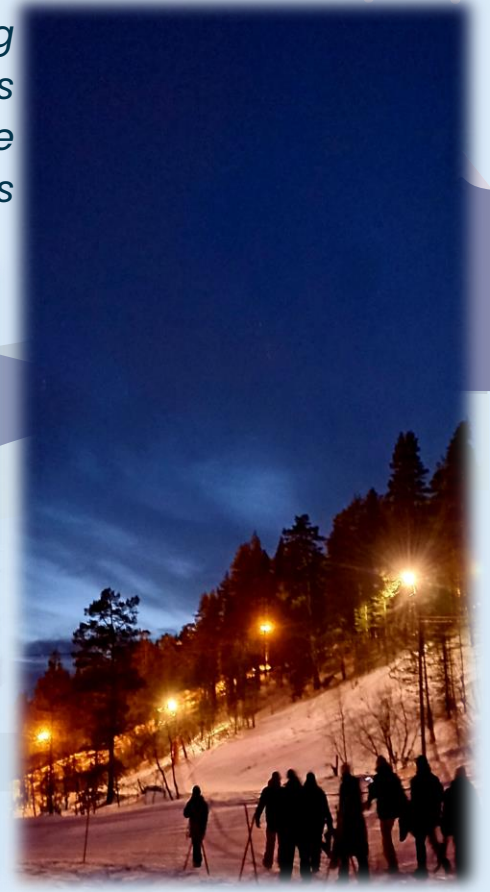
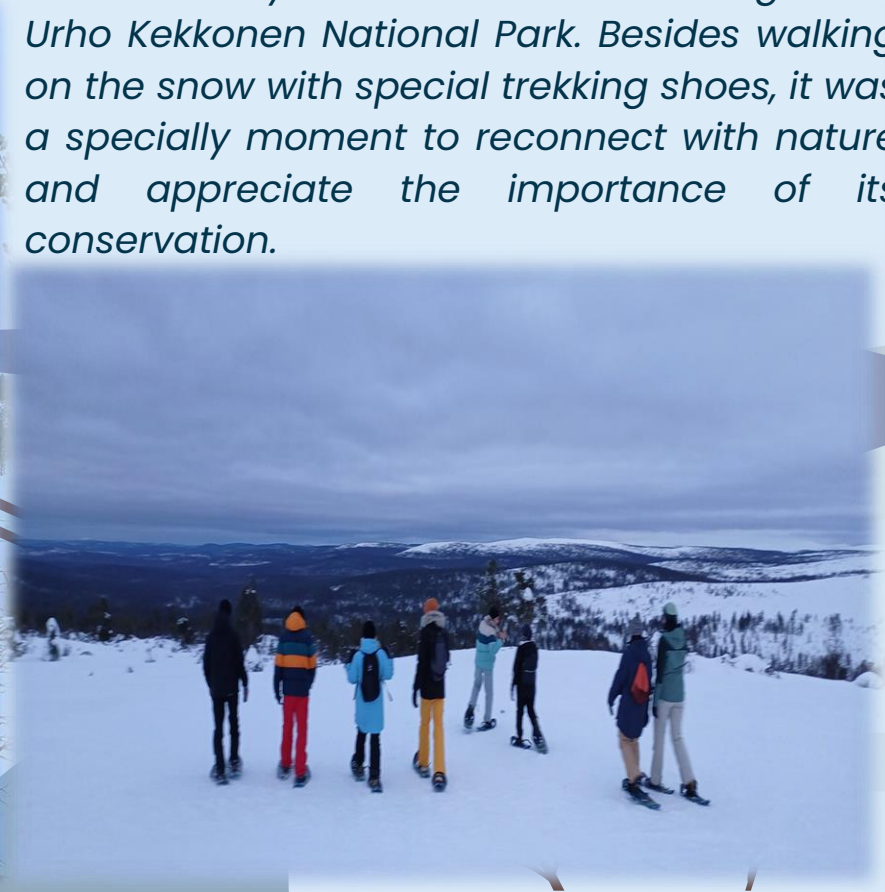
# Day 3

# Day 4: Ice skating at lake Inari

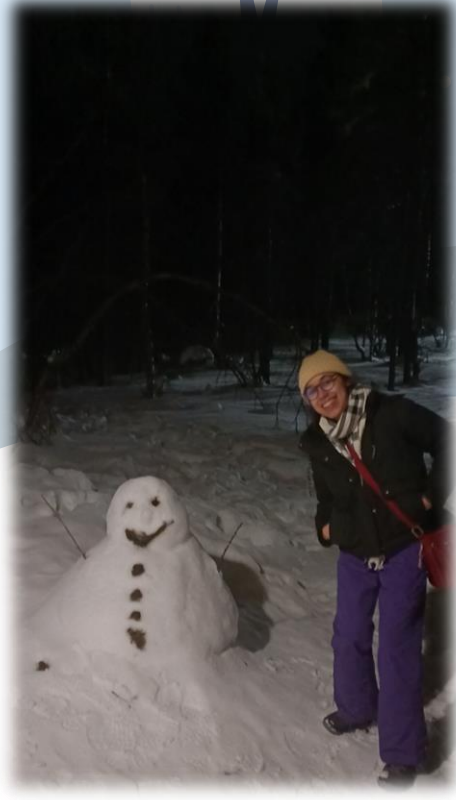
*We had the opportunity to ice skate on the frozen lake Inari. Its was an amazing experience full of fun, falls, and ice.*

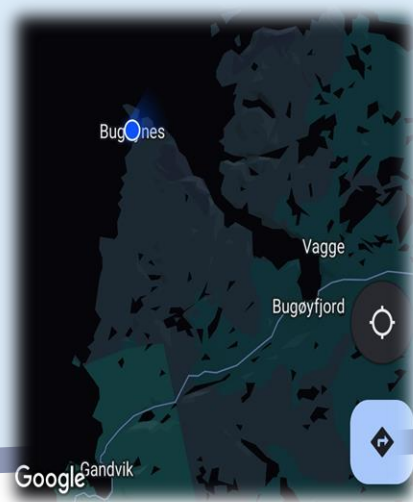


# Bugøynes, Norway

# Day 6: The last day

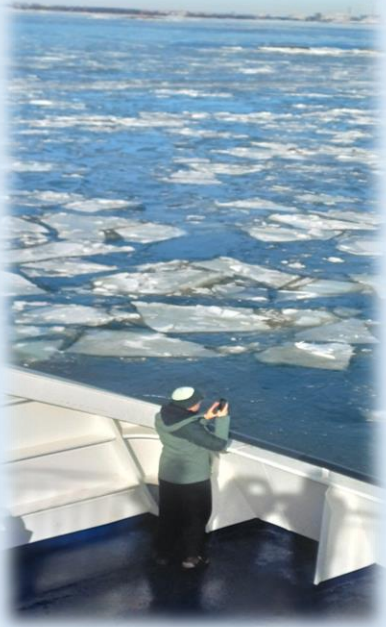
*Last day was saved for visiting the town one last time, a little of souvenir shopping and , going sledging before heading back to Tallinn.*
